WE DO NOT PROMISE ANY CHILD OR FAMILY THEY CAN BE ON A CERTAIN TEAM OR PLAY WITH A FRIEND. WE WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO ACCOMMODATE AS MANY REQUESTS AS POSSIBLE. ALL REQUESTS WILL BE TAKEN UNDER CONSIDERATION AT THE DRAFT.

- 1. **BATTING HELMETS:** The league no longer provides batting helmets for players due to health concerns. This policy was established over 6 years ago.
- 2. **EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER:** We must have an **Emergency Phone Number** other than home phone. Please indicate if it is a cell phone, family, friend, etc.
- 3. **NEW TELEPHONE NUMBER or EMAIL ADDRESS?:** Contact <u>gbbbleague@yahoo.com</u> as soon as possible with your new phone number or email address. We will share this information with the appropriate managers and league officials.
- 4. REGISTRATION FEES (\$25.00 Return Check Fee Applies if your check is returned by your bank unpaid):

T-Ball:	6 & Under (Boys & Girls) – \$50.00
Baseball:	8 & Under – \$95.00 10 & Under – \$110.00 12 & Under – \$120.00 15 & Under (90 Foot) – \$155.00 18 & Under (90 Foot) – \$155.00

- 5. REFUNDABLE FUNDRAISER: Each family must purchase a book of 60 raffle tickets. The cost is added to the registration fee. The Managers will distribute tickets shortly after Player Draft. The family sells the tickets and returns the stubs to the Concession Stand by 12:00 Noon on Opening Day. The family keeps the \$60.00 they paid at registration for selling each book. The Raffle will be drawn on Opening Day, weather permitting.
- 6. **OPENING DAY:** Tentative date, subject to change -- Saturday, April 15th, 2023.
- 7. PICTURES: A Saturday, Sunday, or weeknight in April or May, To Be Determined.
- 8. **INSURANCE:** Our accidental medical insurance is a secondary coverage policy with a deductible.

- 9. **TEAM MANAGER**: will call to inform you when the first practice will take place. Make sure you get the manager's name and phone number when they call around the second week of March after Player Draft. If registrations are delayed (e.g., inclement weather), it will be later in the month.
- 10. WHERE TEAMS PRACTICE AND PLAY: Sawmill Creek Park (Home Field) on Dorsey Road, Richard Henry Lee Elementary School, Pt. Pleasant Elementary School and Glen Burnie Park Elementary School.
- 11. **TIME & SCHEDULES:** Typically 6:00 PM on weekdays and varying times on Saturday or Sunday. Make-up games might be played on Saturdays and Sundays. Game Schedules will be distributed by Opening Day or as soon as possible.
- 12. UNIFORMS: The league provides complete uniforms for all players. They get to keep their uniform at the end of the season. No other uniforms should be worn at league-scheduled ballgames.

- 14. **COACHES CERTIFICATION CLINIC:** There are Coaches Certification Clinics held throughout the year. Registration begins at 6:00 PM, and the clinic begins promptly at 6:30 PM. The clinic last for about two hours. We strongly encourage all managers and coaches to attend every three years. The clinic is very informative and **free** to attend.
- 15. MANAGER & COACH PROSPECTS: Any returning managers or coaches are invited to apply for a coaching position for 2023. If you happen to be moving up an age group to follow your child, please recommend any coaches you worked with that may be interested in managing a team in the league you're moving up from. Recommendations are the best way to build a list of prospective managers and coaches.
- 16. **TEAM PARENTS:** Team parents collect player packets for team pictures, hand out fundraiser packets, help managers with phone calls and schedule snacks for younger teams, if needed. Please let your manager know if you are interested in helping out with these important tasks.
- 17. **THE INSIDE PITCH NEWSLETTER:** Each family will be emailed a league newsletter (*The Inside Pitch*) at registration and during the season. Please notify us at <u>gbbbleague@yahoo.com</u> if your email address changes, so you will continue receiving your newsletter from the league.
- 18. **PLAYER DRAFTS:** League VP's and Managers will meet to draft players on or around Sunday, March 5th, 2023. It is <u>not</u> necessary for players to attend. This is the meeting where teams will be built.
